1. Welcome

- 2. Treasurer's Report Elise
 - There is \$81, 529.06 in the account. There is \$202.41 in PayPal. Total available funds is \$81,731.47. Out of this, we estimate about \$66,600 spent/earmarked:
 - Science and PE is estimated to be \$34,000
 - Math Impact approx. \$17,000
 - World Music is approx. \$6000
 - Kinder Aid is approx. \$9600
 - There are some expenses too: red envelope, printing, domains, insurance, taxes, etc.
 - New version of Quickbooks ordered. Free online copy donated by Intuit.

 - Found someone to be the math teacher. As soon as we give Cindy the deposit, she can put in the paperwork.
